



PUBLIC FIRE RESTRICTIONS

ODF South Cascade District - REGULATED CLOSURE PROCLAMATION
 ORS 477.535 to 477.550

Effective 12:01 a.m., PDT, June 16th, 2021



Burning backyard debris	Prohibited At All Times
Smoking while traveling in forestlands, except in vehicles on improved roads, in boats on the water, and at designated locations.	
Use of fireworks, exploding targets, tracer ammunition & sky lanterns.	
Firefighting equipment is required while traveling on forestland, except on state highways, county roads, and driveways: one shovel, one axe or pulaski and one gallon of water or one 2.5 pound or larger ABC fire extinguisher.	Required At All Times
All electric fence controllers in use shall: 1) be listed by nationally recognized laboratory or certified by the Department of Consumer and Business Services, and 2) Operated in compliance with manufacturer's instructions.

Open fires, including campfires, charcoal fires, cooking fires, and warming fires. Portable cooking stoves using liquefied or bottled fuels are allowed.	Only with Landowner Permission	Only at Designated Locations	Only at Designated Locations	Not Allowed
Motor vehicles, including motorcycles and all terrain vehicles, are only allowed on <u>improved</u> roads free from flammable vegetation, except for the cultivation and harvest of agricultural crops	Allowed All Day	Allowed All Day	Allowed All Day	Allowed All Day
Motor vehicles, including motorcycles and all terrain vehicles, are restricted on <u>unimproved</u> roads, except for the cultivation and harvest of agricultural crops	Allowed All Day	Allowed before 1pm & after 8pm	Allowed before 10am & after 8pm	Not Allowed
Powersaw use is restricted. When allowed each saw being used is required to have one shovel and one fire extinguisher of at least 8 ounce capacity. A Fire Watch of at least one hour is required following the use of each saw.				
Cutting, grinding, and welding of metal is restricted to areas that are in a cleared area and has a charged garden hose or one 2 1/2 pound or larger fire extinguisher immediately available.				
Mowing dried, cured grass with power driven equipment is restricted. The cultivation and harvest of agricultural crops is exempt from this requirement.				
Any other spark-emitting internal combustion engine not specifically mentioned is restricted. When conducted in a cleared area, a charged garden hose or one 2 1/2 pound or larger fire extinguisher must be immediately available.
